

# **Bradley James Anderson**

## **Memorial Scholarship**

Bradley J. "Brad" Anderson passed away March 7, 2010 from injuries resulting from a snowmobile accident. He was only 51 years young. Brad left behind his wife of over 30 years, Marjie, their son Luke and daughter Sabrina Weller. He also left behind three grandchildren and his brother Jeff and family.

Brad was an avid outdoorsman, enjoying fishing, hunting, boating, and snowmobiling. He also enjoyed his work with Alliant Energy where he worked for over 30 years and was a Lead Line Technician. Brad was one of those people that left an impression on everyone he met and had many co-workers and friends that truly miss him.

In order to honor Brad, the Bradley "Brad" Anderson Memorial Scholarship has been established from funds received from family, friends and co-workers. The scholarship is awarded annually to a son or daughter of an Alliant-Wisconsin Power and Light employee, who is a high school senior and will be going on to school in the electrical field. (Line Technician, Electrician, Electrical Engineer or electrical related field)

### Application and Rules

#### **Eligibility**

The Bradley "Brad" Anderson Memorial Scholarship is open to all children of employees at Alliant/WPL who will graduate from high school in the current school year. The Scholarship award is in the amount of \$1000. The Bradley Anderson family will determine the winner. Should there not be any applicants or qualified applicants, the family reserves the right to either not award the scholarship that year or award the scholarship to another deserving individual that will be pursuing a degree/certificate in the electrical field that can show the financial need.

#### **Qualifications**

1. Applications must be received by April 1<sup>st</sup> of each year to Bradley James Anderson Memorial Scholarship, c/o Marjie Anderson, W1381 Silver Canoe Court, Keshena WI 54135.
2. Completion of the application form. Application forms are available by requesting from the above address.
3. Applicants are required to submit a complete personal resume of their notable activities to date. This is to include involvement in high school programs, clubs, sports, community service, and personal goals.
4. Applicants are required to submit an essay of between 50-100 words describing why the applicant is pursuing continued education in the electrical field.

#### **Selection of Winners**

The Brad Anderson family will examine the complete record of each scholarship applicant. Consideration will be given to student resume, goals, letters of recommendation and need. On the basis of these factors, the Brad Anderson family will select the recipient of the Bradley "Brad" Anderson Memorial Scholarship.

#### **Awards**

The scholarship will be awarded upon proof of acceptance into an accredited college, university or technical college as full time students attending at least a one (1) year program. The check will be made payable to the recipients and to the appropriate institution. The scholarship is to be used for all legitimate educational expenses.

## **Responsibilities of Winners**

The winner is expected to attend a college, university or technical college and to take classes appropriate for their chosen curriculum, and to begin study by the first (fall) semester of the following school year.

## **FREE ACT OF THE BRAD ANDERSON FAMILY**

The creation of the scholarship program is a free act of the Brad Anderson family and they retain its right to alter, suspend, cancel or halt the Bradley James Anderson Memorial Scholarship at any time and without giving any reason, provided however, that the scholarship winners already in college, university or technical college under the program have received the scholarships.

## **RULES**

1. The Brad Anderson family will be the sole determining body in establishing, administering and awarding the Bradley James Anderson Memorial Scholarship.
2. Employees will be currently employed or retired from Alliant/WPL on April 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year that the scholarship is being considered.
3. Applications must be post marked by April 1<sup>st</sup> of the current school year.
4. No applications post marked after April 1st will be allowed.
5. Applications must be on an Official application form.
6. Scholarships will be awarded within 3 months of the application deadline.
7. Two (2) letters of recommendations are required and to be attached plus a senior picture if available.
8. Winners will show proof of acceptance in an accredited college, university or technical college.
9. Scholarship checks will be made out in the names of the recipients and the institutions they will attend. Education expenses are defined as tuition, books, tools, room, board, and other educational supplies.
10. Winners will be enrolled by the first semester (fall) of the following school year as full-time students in at least a one-year program.
11. The Brad Anderson family will be notified two (2) weeks prior to the start of classes if the recipients do not attend or are unable to attend his or her choice of higher education and funds will be returned.
